- 11. The RTÉ Guide and Puffin cannot accept responsibility for late or lost entries and will not return entries.
- 12. Winners will be selected by a judging panel, nominated by RTÉ and Puffin, whose decision is final. No correspondence will be entered into.
- 13. Winners will be contacted directly by telephone or email within 28 days of the closing date.
- 14. The Winner in each category will receive an e-Reader Kindle and a hamper of books.
- 15. The two Runners-up in each category will receive a hamper of books.
- 16. The Winners and Runners-up in each category will receive a free annual subscription to the RTÉ Guide.
- 17. The Winner and Runners-up in each category will be invited to attend an awards ceremony in RTÉ.
